

Code of Conduct

Our code of conduct is based on the 5 tenets of Taekwondo and all club members are expected to follow it:

Courtesy - Behave with courtesy and respect towards others.

Integrity - Be honest, do not cheat and do not tolerate dishonesty in others.

Perseverance - Keep trying, don't give up when you find something difficult.

Self Control - Your words or actions can cause harm to others, consider this before you act.

Indomitable Spirit - Stand up for your beliefs and give 100% effort in all that you do.

As a member of our club we expect you to:

- Treat everyone fairly and with respect. If you are concerned by any behaviour you have witnessed or experienced, please speak to one of our senior instructors. There are contact details on our website or you can contact us through our facebook page.
- Help your fellow students to succeed. Taekwondo is competitive, but outside of formal competition you should help your fellow students to gain skills and progress.
- Try and keep trying! No one can do everything first try.
- Do not use foul, sexist or racist language at any time.
- Arrive for class in good time and wear your uniform and belt for training.
- Follow the instructions given to you by your teachers.
- Do not do anything that could cause injury. Some of our training venues have gymnastics equipment, these are not a playground and not to be used unless supervised by an instructor.
